Johnson said that he received a screenshot of the suspects scanned picture from Denver Police Officer Kramer. The suspects had been pointed out to Officer Kramer by a bouncer at the club as the people involved in the shooting. Cpl. Officers located Mr. Lynch hiding inside a bedframe inside a bedroom of the apartment.

Your Affiant completed a photographic lineup containing Mr. Lynch. and and were unable to make an identification but did not rule out Mr. Lynch when viewing the lineup. Your Affiant observed that Mr. Lynch's appearance differs from booking photograph that was used in the lineup which was from 2018.
