I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 07/29/2020 at 10:11 pm at or near the location of 1400 BLK N BROADWAY ST in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:
[On 072920, at about 2211 hours, officers from the Denver Police Department were in the area of the 1400 block of N Broadway St assisting Colorado State Patrol with a group of people that were actively trying to break down a fence around Veterans Park.

Veterans park and the 1400 block of N Broadway Blvd are in the city and county of Denver and the state of Colorado.

Officers were directed to an area of the 1400 block of N Broadway ST (around 1450 N Broadway ST) to contact an individual that was actively trying to break down the fence and had pushed the fence into the park and was inside the boundaries of the park. The male was described as white male, long hair, wearing a black t-shirt with white writing on it.

Upon arrival, Officers were given specific directions as to the location of this male and officers located the only male in this area matching the description. This male was later identified by Colorado Driver's License as MICHAEL BENNET JACOBS (DOB 10/01/1996). Officers attempted to take JACOBS into custody but he immediately began to violently resist arrest. JACOBS grabbed ahold of Ofc Leon's (Badge #16006) less lethal pepper ball gun. JACOBS attempted to disarm Ofc Leon of this less lethal gun. Officers were able to forcibly pull JACOBS to the ground and get him in custody.

JACOBS was transported to the DDC and placed on an investigative hold.]
